



## URBAN SCARF

Designed for Urth Yarns

**Material:** 2 skeins Urth Monkrom color 3060  
**Size:** 11"/29 cm wide x 69.5"/177 cm long  
**Needles:** US 3/3.25 mm  
**Notions:** Tapestry Needle  
2 stitch markers  
**Gauge:** 36 sts x 36 rows in st st = 4"/10 cm square

### Abbreviations:

CO - Cast on  
EOR - End of Row  
K - Knit  
P - Purl  
PM - Place marker  
Rep - Repeat  
Sl - Slip  
Sts - Stitches

### Pattern Notes:

Knit flat this scarf lets the yarn become the center of attention as the edges gently fold to the wrong side of the work.

If you prefer not to have the edges roll to the back of the work, work them in a rib stitch rather than garter stitch.

### Pattern:

CO 100 sts.  
Place markers 10 sts in from each end (10 sts, m, 80 sts, m, 10 sts).  
Row 1: Sl1, k to EOR. (100 sts)  
Rows 2- 10: Rep Row 1.  
Row 11 (RS): Sl1, k9, p80, k10.  
Row 12 (WS): Sl1, k to EOR.  
Rep rows 11-12 until work measures 68.5"/174 cm or 1"/2.3 cm less than desired length ending with WS row.  
Rep rows 1-9.  
Bind off

### Finishing:

Using tapestry needle, work in loose ends, steam block and lay flat to dry.

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
