



# INSTANT SHAWL KOOZOO

Designed for Urth Yarns by Serpil Aydinay

**Materials:** 2 skeins Urth Koozoo

**Dimensions:** 43"/110cm wingspan,  
16"/43cm deep, not including tassels.

**Needles:** US 17/12mm 24" circular,  
**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch  
marker

**Gauge:** 10 sts x 10 rows = 4"/10 cm in  
Stockinette St

## Abbreviations:

BO – Bind off

CO – Cast on

K – Knit

P - Purl

M1L - With the left needle pick up the strand between 2 stitches, from front to back and knit through the back loop.

M1R - With the left needle pick up the strand between 2 stitches, from back to front and knit through the front loop.

M1PL - With the left needle pick up the strand between 2 stitches, from front to back and purl through the back loop.

M1PR - With the left needle pick up the strand between 2 stitches, from back to front and purl through the front loop.

PM – Place Marker

Rep – Repeat

RS – Right Side

SM – Slip Marker

St(s) – stitch(es)

WS – Wrong Side

YO – Yarn over



## Special Stitch Patterns:

**Stockinette Pattern:** (2-row repeat with an increase of 6 sts per repeat)

Row 1 (RS): K1, m1r, k to m, m1r, sm, k1, sm, m1l, k to last st, m1l, k1. (4 sts inc)

Row 2 (WS): K1, m1pr, p to last sts, m1pl, k1. (2 sts inc)

**Drop Stitch Pattern:** (8-row repeat with an increase of 16 sts per repeat)

Row 1,3(RS): K1, m1r, k to m, m1r, sm, k1, sm, m1l, k to last st, m1l, k1. (4 sts inc)

Row 2,4(WS): K1, m1pr, k to m, sm, p1, sm, k to last st, m1pl, k1. (2 sts inc)

Row 5 (RS): K1, \*yo twice, k1, rep from \* to 1 st before m, k1, sm, k1, sm, \*yo twice, k1, repeat from \* to last st, k1.

Row 6 (WS): Knit across dropping the yo loops to m, sm, p1, sm, knit across dropping the yo loops to last st, K1.

Row 7 (RS): K1, m1r, k to m, sm, k1, sm, k to last st, m1l, k1. (2 sts inc)

Row 8 (WS): K1, m1pr, k to m, sm, p1, sm, k to last st, m1pl, k1. (2 sts inc)

**Garter Stitch Pattern:** (2-row repeat with an increase of 2 sts per repeat)

Row 1 (RS): K1, m1r, k to m, sm, k1, sm, k to last st, m1l, k1. (2 sts inc)

Row 2 (WS): K1, k to m, sm, p1, sm, k to last st, k1.

### Pattern Notes:

A quick triangular knit worked from the top down. Set aside about 39'/12m of yarn first to have enough for three tassels like those pictured. Tassels measure 4"/10 cm finished. How to make a yarn tassel and attach it to a project: <https://youtu.be/THGfilFnhjl>

### Pattern:

CO 5 sts

Place markers before knitting the 1st row as foll:

2 st, pm, 1 st, pm, 2 st.

Rows 1 - 6: Stockinette Pattern. (23 sts)

Rows 7- 14: Drop Stitch Pattern. (39 sts)

Rows 15 - 16: Stockinette Pattern. (45 sts)

Rows 17 - 24: Drop Stitch Pattern. (61 sts)

Rows 25 - 26: Stockinette Pattern. (67 sts)

Rows 27 - 34: Drop Stitch Pattern. (83 sts)

Rows 35 - 36: Garter Stitch Pattern. (85 sts)

BO all sts.

### Finishing:

Weave in yarn ends. Steam or wet block the shawl.

Lay flat to dry. Add tassels to side and bottom points if desired.
